



SPRING CONCERT 5TH MARCH 2022

NOTES FOR AUDIENCE REGARDING COVID -19 MEASURES

Before the event

Advance purchase of tickets is recommended.

Ticket sales will be available on the door where touchless card payment is available and recommended.

There will be a clearly marked and separate entrances for people who already have tickets so that queues can be reduced, more distancing can be achieved before the event and ticket holders can move quickly straight to their seats.

At the event

You might be asked to queue on arrival for a short while to avoid over crowding but there will be stewards to guide and inform you.

Hand sanitiser will be provided

Please be respectful of each others space

Seating in the auditorium will not be socially distanced

Whilst there is no longer a legal requirement for people to wear face coverings. People are still advised to wear one in crowded and indoor spaces where they may come into contact with people they do not normally meet. Please wear a face covering whenever you are inside and not seated. You are encouraged to wear one even when seated.

Paper programmes will be available and will have been quarantined before the event so that they are safe to handle

We will keep some doors and windows open for as long as we can to improve ventilation

There will be volunteers on hand to help explain how the event will work and any procedures we have in place

The concert will last approximately 2 hours

We ask that you leave the auditorium if possible during the interval as we will be ventilating the space
Unfortunately we cannot provide refreshments, but you are welcome to bring your own
